

Report on Anti-Ragging Program

The Anti-Ragging Program was organized in the campus of Mundeshwari College for Teacher Education on **18/08/2025** with the objective of spreading awareness among students about the harmful effects of ragging and promoting a culture of respect, harmony, and safety on campus. The program was conducted under the guidance of the Anti-Ragging Committee and in accordance with the directives of the University Grants Commission (UGC).

The session began with a welcome address by the **IQAC coordinator**, Kumari Shashi Singh, who highlighted the importance of maintaining discipline and ensuring a ragging-free environment in the institution and explained the legal consequences of ragging as per the UGC regulations and the punishments for offenders. Students were also informed about the helpline numbers, grievance redressal mechanisms, and the role of the college's Anti-Ragging Cell.
