
Plantation Drive 2018



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

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International Yoga Day 2018

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

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

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Educational Excursion 12/01/2019

Human Resource Development


The scheme has three primary objectives

Ensure every girl child gets a quality education.





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Road Safety Awareness





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Blood Donation Camp

- Mundeshwari College for Teacher Education, Patna, organized a blood donation camp on the MCTE campus. This event encouraged students and staff to donate blood and help save the lives of people in need. The primary objective of the blood donation camp was to address the ongoing blood shortage in local hospitals and medical facilities. By encouraging community members to donate blood, the aim was to replenish blood supplies and potentially save lives. Donors were greeted by volunteers and directed to the registration area, where they provided their personal information and underwent a brief medical screening to ensure eligibility for donation. Eligible donors proceeded to the donation area, where trained medical staff collected blood samples using sterile equipment. Donors reclined comfortably during the donation process, which typically lasted around 10–15 minutes per donor.





Dowry is called dahez in Hindi and as jahez in Urdu. The dowry system can put great financial burden on the bride's family. The Dowry Prohibition Act, enacted on May 1, 1961, intended to prevent the giving or receiving of a dowry. Under the Dowry Prohibition Act, dowry includes property, goods, or money given by either party to the marriage, by the parents of either party, or by anyone else in connection with the marriage.



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
Anti-Drug Awareness Program

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

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Swachhta Pakhwara 03/10/2023 to 05/10/2023

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
Har-Ghar Tiranga




