1. Curriculum Aspects

- **Strengths:**

- The curriculum is aligned with Aryabhata Knowledge University's framework and incorporates modern teaching methods, including digital tools and internship opportunities. The curriculum is updated regularly to reflect current educational trends.
- The fully implemented 360 Degree **feedback mechanism** to gather input from Teacher, Student, Parent, alumni and industry professionals on curriculum relevance

- **Recommendations:**

- Introduce **skill-based elective courses** such as communicative English, ICT proficiency, and soft skills.
- Enhance **vocational training** to improve employability prospects for students.

2. Teaching-Learning and Evaluation

- **Strengths:**

Faculty employ a blend of traditional teaching methods and ICT tools, ensuring that students receive a comprehensive education. Regular assessments (internal exams, assignments, presentations) ensure continuous evaluation.

The college also conducts **remedial classes** for weaker students and provides **mentorship** through faculty advisors.

- **Mentor Mentee System** successfully implemented

- **Recommendations:**
 - Strengthen the mentoring system by increasing **faculty-student interaction**, focusing on individualized academic support.
 - Provide **ICT training** to faculty members to further integrate digital learning tools into classrooms.
 - Introduce **peer evaluation** among students to promote collaborative learning and self-improvement.

3. Research, Consultancy, and Extension

- **Strengths:**

Most of the faculty pursuing Ph.Ds, with active participation in research and Academic oriented UGC-approved activities and programmes. The institution encourages faculty and student participation in community service through NSS (National Service Scheme) activities.

- **Strengths:**



 - Average pass percentage 100% total number of pass out students 97 session 2022-23

 - Successfully 28 students qualified C-TET Examination and 22 Students selection in Government Teachers and 16 Students progression to Higher Education.
